Dr Ho is the director of The Specialists: Lasers, Aesthetic & Plastic Surgery, Hong Kong and is the honorary assistant professor of the Faculty of Medicine, the Chinese University of Hong Kong.

He earned his MBChB degree from the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 1990. He is a fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong, and the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine.

Dr Ho has authored or co-authored over 50 articles in peer-reviewed journals and 3 book chapters, with his work appearing in the Lancet, Dermatologic Surgery, British Journal of Plastic Surgery, Burns and Lasers in Surgery and Medicine. He has lectured extensively on injectables and light source devices, minimally invasive plastic surgery and has pioneered the technique of using Botulinum Toxin A in facial slimming and endoscopic breast reconstruction after breast cancer surgery.

Dr Ho is a trainer in plastic surgery of the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong and a trainer in basic surgical skills for the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh. He is an official trainer for Merz. He was a committee member of the Hong Kong Society of Plastic and Reconstructive & Aesthetic Surgeons, former board member of the Plastic Surgery Board of Hong Kong and treasurer of the Hong Kong Burns Association.
